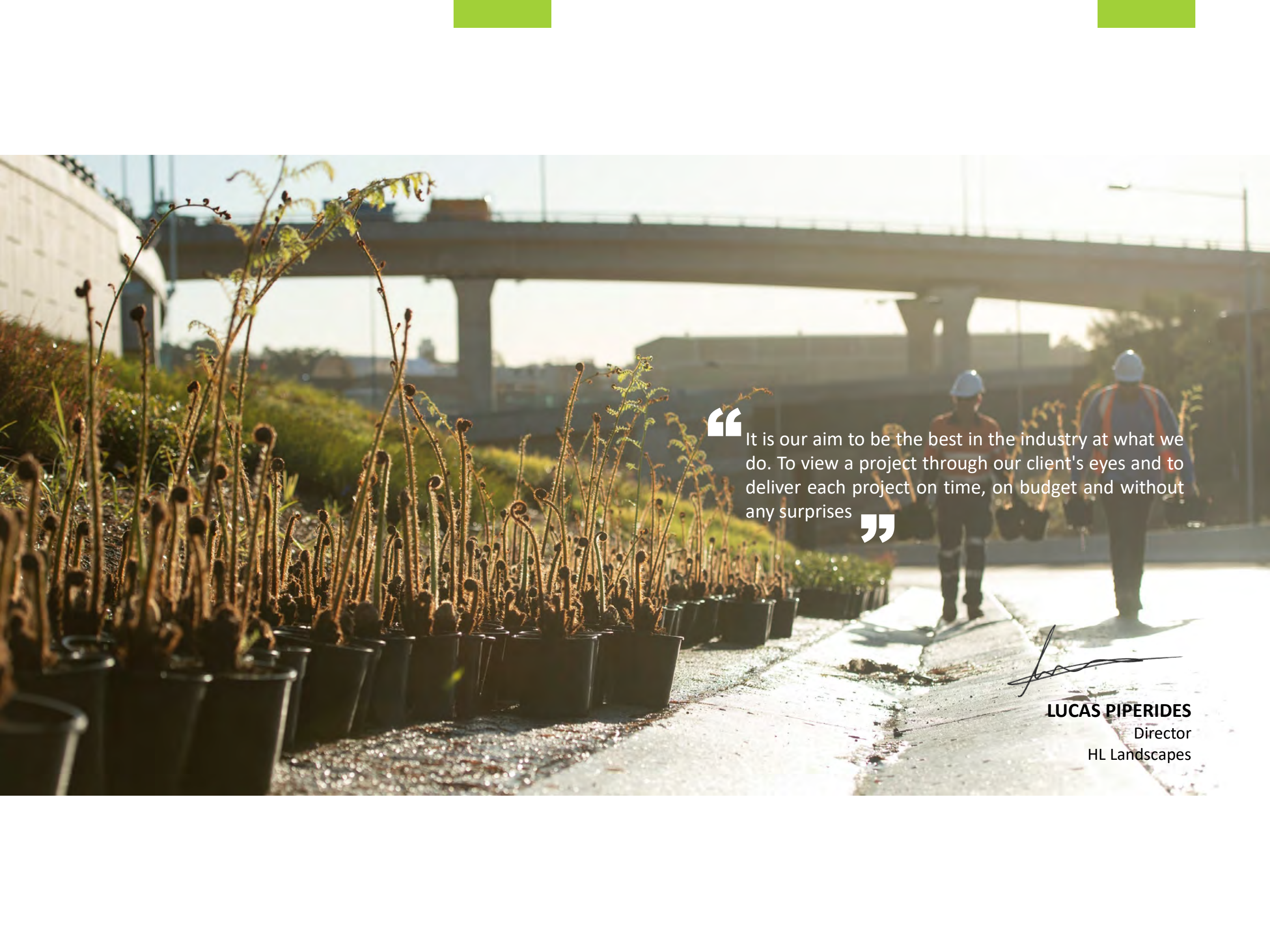

Brisbane Airport New Parallel Runway

HL Landscapes were selected to deliver the landscaping works on the **New Parallel Runway** at the Brisbane Airport, QLD. Working with Skyway JV (CPB / BMD), HL were entrusted to help deliver the country's biggest airport expansion since the 3rd Runway Project in Sydney, NSW.

With the runway now open to air traffic, HL undertook the revegetation of 2 million square metres via several different applications including seeding, stolonising and the laying of turf. As part of the works, HL also installed over 40km of irrigation to ensure the successful establishment of the areas.

Canberra Light Rail – Stage 1

Transport Canberra are rolling out the new **Canberra Light Rail Network** which will deliver a modern transport system that can meet the requirements of a growing, changing city. Construction of stage one of the Light Rail Network is now complete with HL overseeing all the landscaping to the 12 kilometre City to Gungahlin corridor.

The corridor is an important part of the Transport for Canberra policy, which maps out ways to deliver faster, more convenient and more sustainable transport options for Canberra over the next 20 years. Light rail will run from City to Gungahlin, along Northbourne Avenue and Flemington Road. It will deliver high quality, reliable and frequent public transport down one of Canberra's busiest corridors

M5 WestConnex – St Peters Interchange - Sydney

Following our works on the M4 Westconnex, HL were successful in securing the St Peters Interchange in Sydney, NSW as part of the **New M5 Westconnex project**. This signature project is one section of the nation's largest infrastructure project and is aimed at linking Sydney's existing motorway network with connections to Alexandria and Mascot. It also includes connections to the future Sydney Gateway and M4-M5 Link. Local streets and intersections around the St Peters interchange are also being upgraded to ensure safe and efficient connections for the New M5.

Woolgoolga to Ballina – Northern NSW

This \$4.3 billion project is Australia's largest regional infrastructure project. NSW Roads and Maritime Services will deliver the project using a Delivery Partner model similar to the approach used for the construction of the London Olympics infrastructure. The project involves the duplication of approximately 155 kilometres of road to a four-lane divided road on the Pacific Highway. The upgrade will begin 6 kilometres north of Woolgoolga and end approximately 6 kilometres south of Ballina. HL Landscapes will be completing sections 7, 8 and 9 to the north and Section 3 to the south.

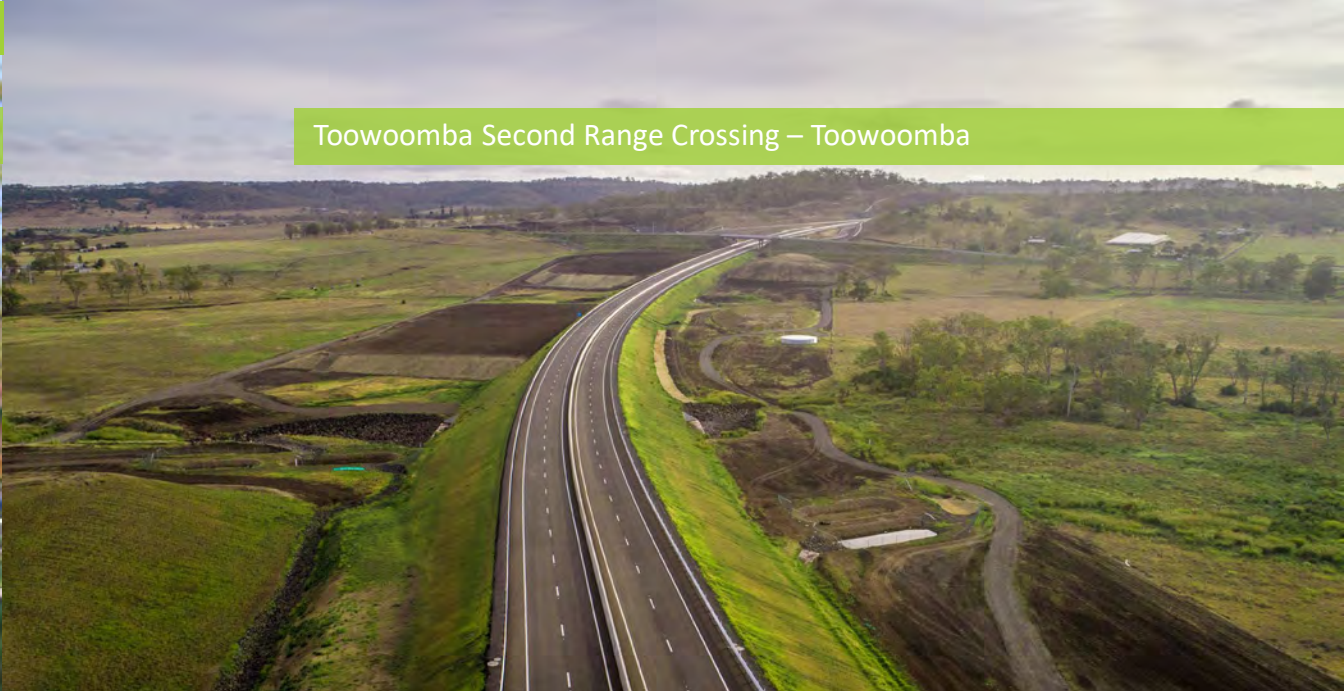

Veloway Stage 1 - Brisbane

HL Landscapes were awarded the landscape package for the new Veloway Stage E Cycle Way project running from Holland Park West to Tarragindi in South Brisbane. Working with McIlwain Civil Constructions, HL were responsible for delivering all landscaping works including soil amelioration, top soiling, mulching and supply and installation of trees and plants.

Toowoomba Second Range Crossing – Toowoomba

The **Toowoomba Second Range Crossing** is a highway construction project that will route heavy vehicle traffic around Toowoomba in Queensland. The route, being delivered by the Department of Transport & Main Roads and Nexus Consortium, will be 41 kilometres long and will pass Toowoomba on its northern side, linking the Warrego Highway at Helidon Spa in the east and the Gore Highway at Athol in the west (via Charlton). HL Landscapes were awarded both the East and the West sections of works and have now successfully completed the delivery of over 4 million square meters of landscape revegetation.

Sports Drive to Gateway Motorway (Stage 1) – Brisbane

HL Landscapes were awarded the landscape works package for stage one of the M1 upgrade (Eight Mile Plains to Daisy Hill). Partnering with Bielby Holdings, HL will be responsible for the soil placement, hydromulching, turfing, mulching and planting. The upgrade between Eight Mile Plains and Daisy Hill will reduce travel time and congestion, improve safety, and increase traffic flow.

Leakes Road – Melbourne

HL Landscapes were successful in securing their second project win in Victoria. Partnering with Winslow contractors, they will be delivering the landscape package to the 8km long Leakes road widening project in Truganina, west Melbourne. HL's scope includes minor earthworks, hydroseeding, mulching and the supply and installation of over 127,000 plants.

Northern Road - Sydney

HL Landscapes have been awarded the landscape works packages for two stages on the new Northern Road upgrade project in Sydney. Partnering with CPB Contractors, HL has been awarded the civil landscaping works to both Stages 5 and 6. HL's scope includes the supply and installation of over a million plants and trees, bio-basin works, installation of mulch, turfing and maintenance. The Northern Road upgrade project will upgrade road infrastructure between Littlefields Road in Luddenham and Glenmore Parkway in Glenmore Park, including upgrading 6.7km of road from two lanes to a divided four-lane alignment, with the provision of kerbside bus lanes at each intersection.

Tabulam Bridge crossing – Northern NSW

Partnering with Georgiou contractors, HL Landscapes were awarded the construction of the landscape works to the new Tabulam Bridge project located on the Clarence River at Tabulam. HL's scope includes hydromulching, turfing, planting and mulch installation. The project involves the construction of a new 290 metre long concrete bridge, as well as improvements to the road approaches to the new bridge.

Logan Enhancement Project – Brisbane

Transurban Queensland's \$512 million **Logan Enhancement Project** included widening sections of the Logan and Gateway motorways, improving key congestion hot spots (Logan Motorway/Mt Lindesay Highway/Beaudesert Road interchange and the Wembley Road/Logan Motorway interchange) and constructing new south-facing on and off-ramps on the Gateway Motorway at Compton Road. HL Landscapes have now successfully completed their works on this project which included the planting and mulching to all batters and installing in excess of over 500,000 plants.

Indooroopilly Riverwalk Bridge – Brisbane

Western Roads - Melbourne



Following on from our works on the Leakes Road project, HL have been successful in securing two packages on the new Western Roads upgrade project in Melbourne. Partnering with WBHO Contractors, HL has been awarded the civil landscaping works to both the Derrimut Rd (Package 3) upgrade and Forsyth Rd (package 7) upgrade. HL's scope includes the spreading of site topsoil, supply and installation of mulch, turfing and planting of tubestock and trees. The Western Roads Upgrade will improve 8 main roads across West Melbourne.

Sydney Light Rail – Sydney



The CBD and South East Light Rail is a new light rail network for Sydney, which is now open to the public. The 12km route features 19 stops, extending from Circular Quay along George Street to Central Station, through Surry Hills to Moore Park, then to Kensington and Kingsford via Anzac Parade and Randwick via Alison Road and High Street. HL Landscapes have now completed their works on this amazing infrastructure project.

- All HL iPads are under a MDM system which give us the ability to role out applications quickly at any given time.

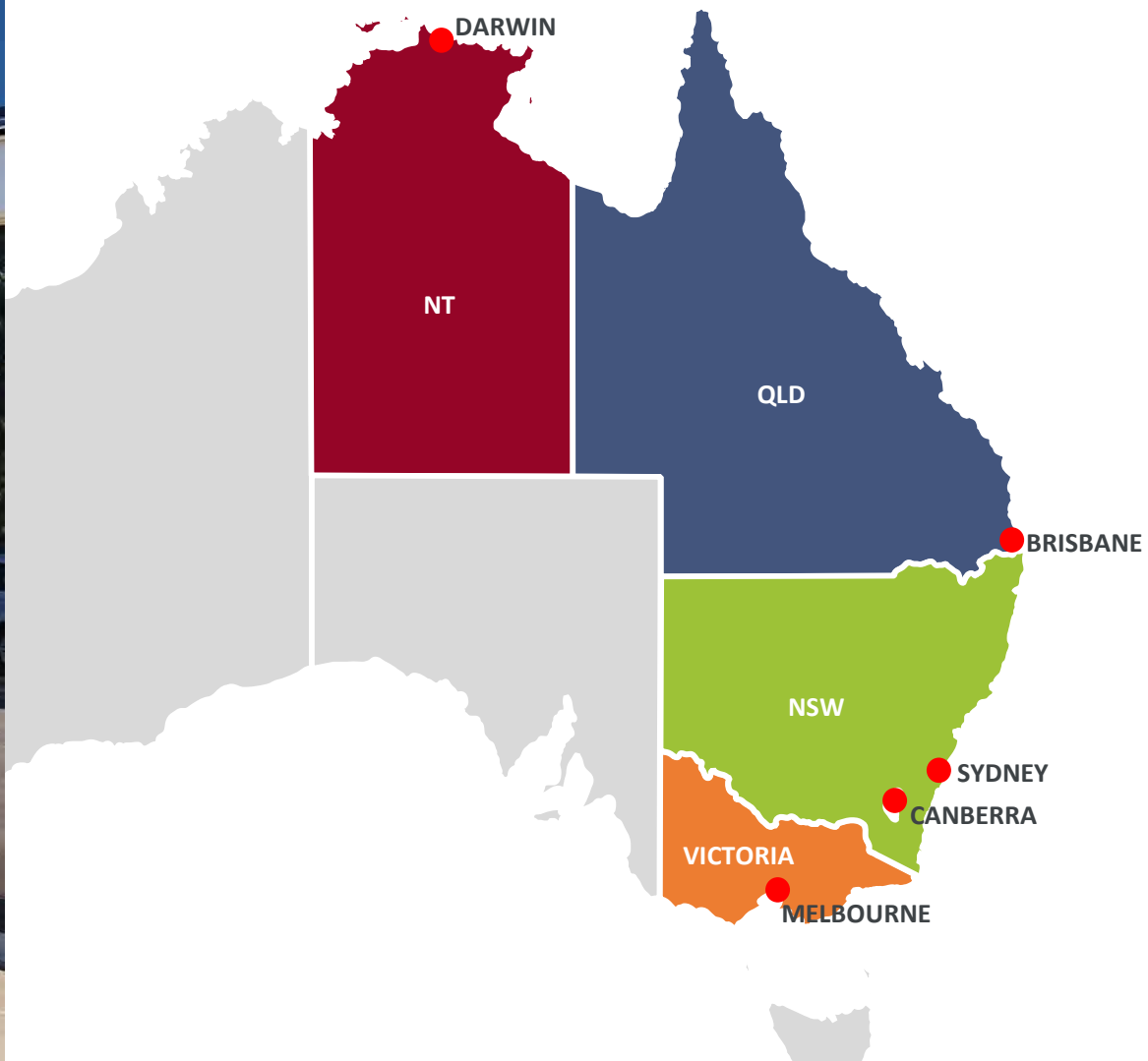
